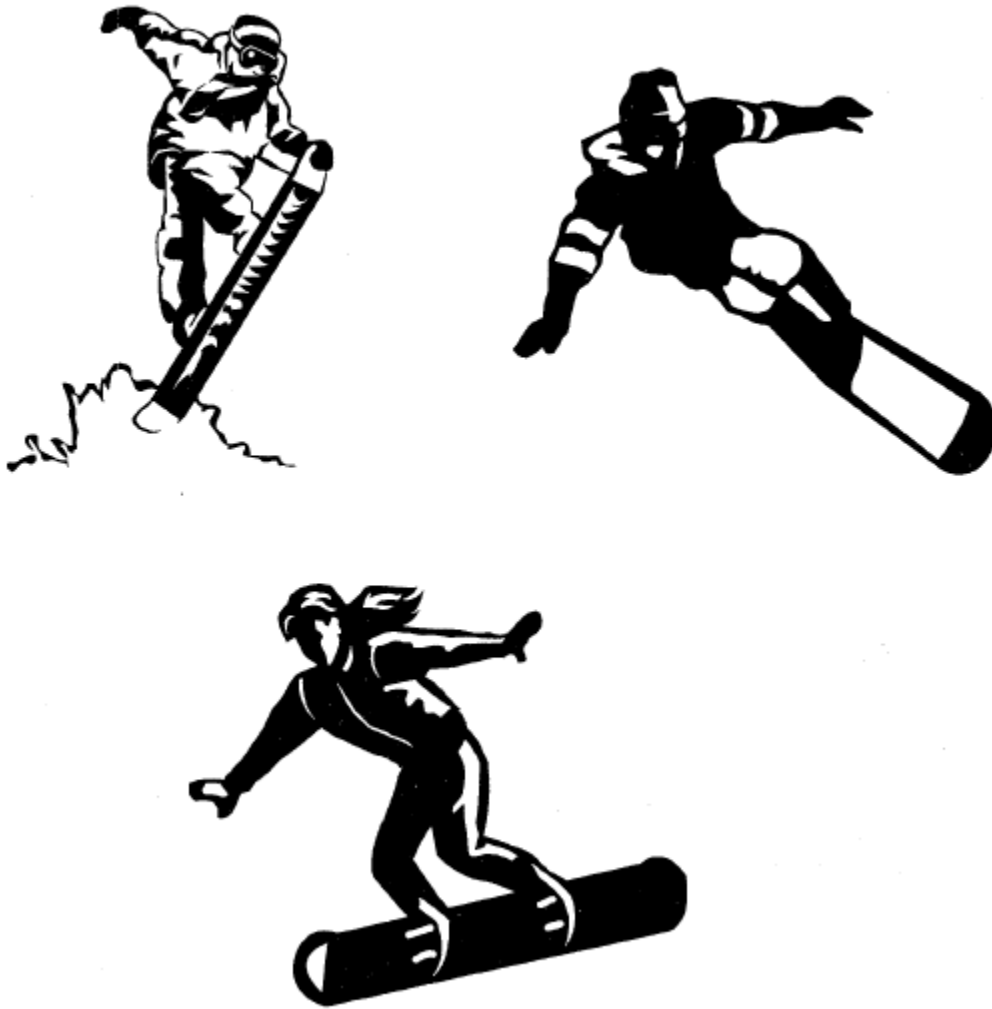

Topics

1. Sign-in and get some snacks.
2. Use our website for answers to everything, www.lincolnsnowboarding.com. Remember, everything. Contact Malee or me if something is not there and it will be added.
3. Why Lincoln Snowboarding? You can be part of a special group. The best coaches (Malee, David, Jesse), outstanding spirit, lots of fun, and some great snowboarders. Two levels of participation: Snowboard team (already know how to snowboard and we provide coaching and competitions) and Snowboard club (teach you how to snowboard with SOS Outreach, includes 5 lessons with equipment rental, lift ticket, and lessons; plus three more rides to the mountain with more lessons)
4. Eligibility: Anyone who lives in Lincoln boundaries, could attend Lincoln or is at a school with no OISA team.
5. Academic requirements to compete
 - a. Enrolled in and passing 5 classes or a senior on track to graduate
 - b. No use of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol while involved in team activities
6. School letter requirements
 - a. Participate in at least 7 of 8 (or 8 of 10) practices + one competition (all competitions are at the varsity level)
 - b. Participate in at least 6 of 8 (or 7 of 10) practices + two competitions
7. **Parent volunteers. Team cannot run without volunteers. Will have links from our website to volunteer opportunities. Per the registration, everyone contributes \$50 to be reimbursed if you volunteer. PARENTS, bond with your young adults on Wednesdays and Saturday/Sunday competitions. I can't remember how many times young adults have told me they wished that their Dad or Mom was involved.**
8. Mt. Hood Meadows lift tickets. Sale now through November 6, can buy online. Ages 15 to 22 are \$379 through the spring season, \$259 if 14. Best rate of the year.
9. Communications. I e-mail a lot and we will post updates on the website. What is our website? We also have a Facebook page.
10. Registration online through our website, homepage or the forms page. Registration packet turn-in meeting on Saturday, November 5 (details to be provided). Can turn in up until November 12 with a \$25 late fee. You will need to make a special case and my kind heart to turn in after November 12.
11. Cost: \$400 competition/\$350 new boarders includes all fees, transportation, insurance, coaching, etc. Optional \$30 for a zipped hooded sweatshirt (help pick a design) and \$10 extra for your name/nickname on the sleeve. **A parent needs to e-mail or call me so I know they saw this page.**
